#### Public Notice

Pursuant to Pinelands Commission Resolution PC4-17-10, the Pinelands Commission is providing notice of the public's opportunity to provide comment concerning the Commission staff's determination (i.e. the December 9, 2015 Certificate of Filing; the February 4, 2016 letter to Paul Flanagan, Executive Director, Board of Public Utilities enclosing the Certificate of Filing and the March 10, 2016 letter to Paul Flanagan, Executive Director, Board of Public Utilities) that the 12.1 mile, 30-inch, natural gas pipeline proposed by New Jersey Natural Gas Company (NJNG) to be constructed within the rights-of-way of Ocean County Routes 539 & 547 (Pinelands Application No. 2014-0045.001) is consistent with the standards of the Pinelands Comprehensive Management Plan. The application, as well as the record developed before the Board of Public Utilities during its consideration of NJNG's petition in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40:55D-19, is on file and available for inspection by appointment at the Pinelands Commission's offices.
